4.0	iTree Eco funding finalisation	
	CE updated all that himself and CK had met with John and further meetings will be held. However, he asked for an agreement to formalise the proportion of each Partner's contribution towards payment. Previously, SCC and Amey had agreed 1/3 of the fee and University of Sheffield had agreed a contribution of £2,000.00. However, since that quote the amounts had increased.	NE
	NE confirmed the £2k contribution from University of Sheffield and suggested that there may be room for some more.	INE
	It was agreed that Amey will pay the full fee and the contributions from SCC and UoS will be sorted out afterwards. Final amounts to be agreed between SCC/Amey and University of Sheffield and updated at the next meeting.	CE
5.0	<u>Darnall Project</u>	
	NE thanked both SS and CE for arranging the Street Tree Wardens walk around. It was good to participate.	
	CE ran through the results of the survey event.	
	It was found that out of the 31 potential locations surveyed, 26 were found to be suitable with scope for a few additional ones not identified in	

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	the desk-top survey. Most of the locations found to be unsuitable during the ground-truthing survey were due to BT cables over-head.	
	Happy to continue to do these on a regular basis, working with Inspectors and becoming a rolling programme to identify other locations.	
	Agreed there are possibly 200 locations in Darnall and agreed to look at these by March 2025.	CE
	Could liaise with LACs and speak at LAC meetings, engagement and see what funding is available.	
	Communications – Could SCC do some communications around the project. LW replied yes there are bulletins that can target audience groups. NRiv – Raised the need for joined up communications.	
	SRWT is also working in Darnall and there are opportunities to collaborate.
